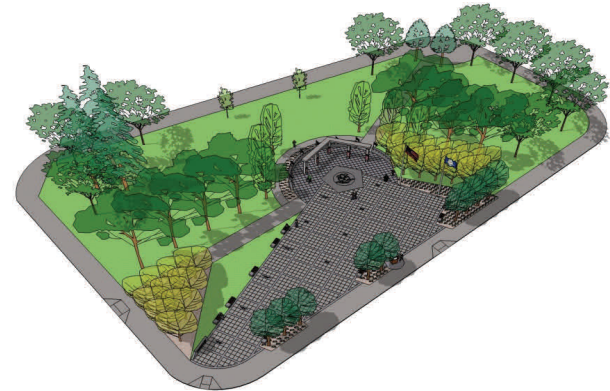
Each paver will hold up to three lines of 15 characters each, including spaces.

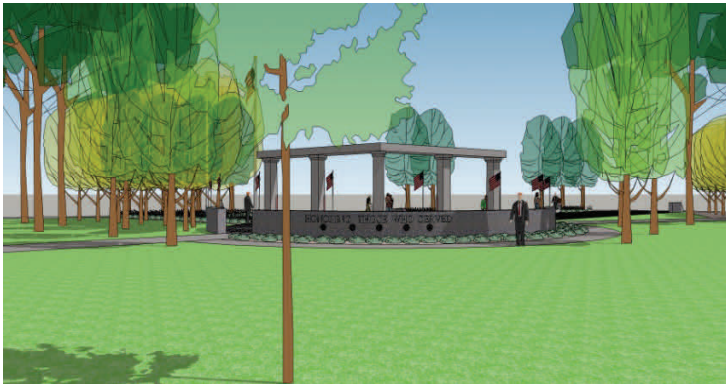
Connecticut State Veterans Memorial

On April 22, 2013, the Groundbreaking took place for the Connecticut State Veterans Memorial at Minuteman Park in Hartford, Connecticut.

The Memorial will be located across from the William A. O'Neill State Armory and the Legislative Office Building. It is now time to begin the construction phase of this glorious project and we welcome all to be part of this monumental and memorable event.

From this Memorial Day, May 27, 2013 through July 4, 2013, we are offering you the opportunity to purchase a 12" x 6" x 2.5" granite paver to honor a Veteran for \$150 each while supplies last. After July 4, the price of this paver will be \$250 per paver. Your Veteran's name, rank and military service can be engraved on the paver.

Below is a view of Paver Walkway from the Legislative Office Building (This is one of the walkways that will contain the Veteran Pavers with your Veteran's information on it.) Actual size is 12" wide, 6" high and 2.5" deep.
